Dear Prospective Member,

Thank you for your interest in joining Knollwood Swim Club! Our swim club offers a family friendly low-key environment, a beautiful park like private setting, and a sense of community. At Knollwood Swim Club, every member is considered an owner and all co-op members work together to support the club by contributing service as needed.

The club year runs from May 1, 2018 to April 30, 2019. We offer a family membership with annual dues of \$595 plus tax. In order to be considered for membership, we require payment of the family membership fee as well as a completed application.

Knollwood members are also asked to pay a one-time, partially refundable bond of \$800. New members are not required to begin making bond payments until the completion of their first summer of swimming. At the end of the first swim season, the choice is yours: If you decide to continue your membership, your bond payment can be made in 4 easy installments of \$200 each beginning on September 30, 2018. If you decide Knollwood is not for you, you can simply end your membership in September, with no bond obligation.

About Us

We are a co-operative swimming club in Webster, NY, that has offered safe recreation for members, their families and guests since 1958. We focus on family oriented activities, recreational swimming, Red Cross swimming lessons (free to members), special activities including: water aerobics, teen nights, family picnics, fun days, adult steak roast, ice cream social and family fun nights.

Our club is located south off of Shoemaker Road (between Hard and Holt Roads) on a nicely treed, secluded, and well-maintained park-like lot. We have: two heated, fenced pools - 25' x 50' (depth from 3' - 8') with a diving board and an 8' x 8' children's pool; a cabana with changing rooms, bathrooms and showers; large lawn and play area; picnic tables; grill and refrigerator; lounge and lawn chairs; fire pit; sand volleyball court; Red Cross certified life guards; and safe, convenient off-street parking.

We are a Cooperative Swimming Club

Knollwood is a cooperative club- we all pitch in together. Each member is expected to contribute service as needed. The membership at Knollwood is limited to no more than 40 families. During your membership, you would be asked to: participate in one committee organization (vacuuming, chemicals, maintenance, grounds, etc.), complete 1-2 monthly general cleanings at the pool, work on opening and closing the pool, and consider serving on the Board of Directors.

Pool Season and Hours

The pool season is from approximately Memorial Day to Labor Day weekends and our pools are open daily from 12:30am to 9:00pm with lifeguards on duty. During our 7 weeks of swimming lessons, recreational swimming begins after the last class, approximately 12:30pm until closing.

Swimming Lessons - FREE TO MEMBERS

Our 30 minutes swim lessons are taught by Red Cross certified instructor(s) and are offered Monday through Thursday, for 6 to 7 weeks in the summer. Each swim class is small so every student is able to receive close attention from the instructor. At the end of the swim program, there is a "Fun Day" filled with games and prizes for all swim students.
